This is almost a full rewrite of the real_name module that was created by Oliver Riesen. Here's an overview of the most important changes:

The module now is more flexible in its use by using the Phorum module system for allowing other modules to supply additional custom username rewrite rules, display names, profile links and even HTML formatted profile links (these can be used to fully override the way in which Phorum generates a user's profile link). See the README in the distribution for information on how to plug into the Real Names module from other modules.

The code for stripping text components from real names was removed from this module. This type of task can now be performed by a separate module through the new hooks within this module. For those who need this functionality, I wrote the real_name_stripper module. It is also attached to this message.

Some work was done to make maintaining the username rewriting code easier, to prevent problems due to copying and pasting lots of code. A simple rewrite language was added to make it an easy task to formulate rules that have to be applied to the Phorum data before displaying on screen. The rewrite_rules.src file in the distribution contains

these rules and they will be compiled automatically into PHP code by the `rewrite_rules_compiler` class.

The sorting function for the userlist for user drop down lists didn't work correctly. It did reset the array index numbering, but the index of the array is used as the `user_id` in the drop down lists. This index is now kept intact. The sorting now also is case insensitive to prevent names starting with a lower case character from ending up at the end of the list.

Why not? The real name mod rewrites all occurrences of the username dynamically. If you store the real name in the author field, then the name would not change along with changing the name in the real_name custom user field. Additionally, this way more options are available. For example: on my own site, I do not only display a user's name, but also a profile image button next to their name and some small flagging images for marking moderators and users that are in the chatroom. All I have to code for this, is a small module that adds functionality to the real_name mod.

it's true that the name would not change along with the real_name field. i would think however that this is fine as the user intended to change their name. they may even like posting as a different name every time. doesn't matter much if the profile links all use the user_id anyway.

i guess what confuses me is that is what is the point of the author field at all then? seems kind of redundant if it is never supposed to be anything but what is in the users.username anyway.

It can be user for displaying the author's name, without having to retrieve the name every time from the user table. Redundancy is sometimes necessary for speed (else you might say that Phorum is way too redundant by all the meta data caching that it does).

But there's no reason to keep the author name the same as the username at all. All that is going on here is that you are apparently looking for some other mod than the real_name mod. Since this mod simply displays the real_name instead of the original author name in postings. The description of the mod is not "use any name the author likes at write time and remember that name". I would not want this kind of functionality in the real_name mod.

What you apparently want, sounds more like the [named posting module](#). It's on the modules listing page as well.

This is, because there can be quote hooks active, which change the format of the quote message. I'd have to look into this to see how this could be solved gracefully. At the moment there are two different versions of this module. The [version 1 by Oliver Riesen](#) is an **easy to use** variant. [Version 2 by Maurice Makaay](#) is **more sophisticated** and offers special features for embedded phorum's or sharing user informations. Both versions offers (nearly) the same functionality. So, if you are using your Phorum stand-alone try version 1. If you are using your Phorum as an embedded part of your homepage or if you want to share user informations try version 2.

Embedding has nothing to do with the version 2 module really. It's also not true that version 2 would be harder to use. It's a simple drop-in-and-go-module. I coded version 2 to be functionally the same as version 1.

A big difference is that version 2 offers more flexibility for extending its functionality. By default, the real_name user field is used for translating the username, but developers can write modules that can implement any kind of translation. On my own site, I use this to not only show another name, but also to point the profile link to my own profile system, add an icon for moderators and add an icon if the user is in my chatroom.

Another big difference is that I made up a description language for describing what fields in the page info need translating. This language makes it easier to maintain the long list of rewriting actions. As a user, you do not have to worry about this, but for developers the rewriting code is easier to maintain.

You configured here that `$PHORUM["MOD_LAST_FORUM_POST"]` is an array. Each record in that array would contain a field named "author" and a field named "link_author". These would be rewritten to the real name and profile URL using the id that can be found in the field "user_id". All this has to be done on pages which have the "phorum_page" set to "read" (so basically this has to be done on the read page).

This is wrong, since the mod you're referring to seems to modify the forum description on the index page and it does not fill `$PHORUM["MOD_LAST_FORUM_POST"]` at all. I guess you're just trying to copy some rewrite rules that were written for another mod, without knowing the semantics.

The real_name module does all its rewriting stuff after all processing has been done and before the data is sent to the browser. This means that it lets Phorum fill all the template fields and then overrides the fields that need changing. At every place where a user's name is put in a single template variable (e.g. `$PHORUM["DATA"]["AUTHOR"]` c.q. `{AUTHOR}`), this mod can be told to change the data in that field using the rewrite rules.

The Last Forum Post mod does change the description field of the forums by adding last post info and as such, the name of the author(s) is not separated in a template variable. Instead, all author names are put together inside a block of text with other text surrounding it. Therefore you cannot possibly write real_name rewrite rules for rewriting these names.

Conclusion: Because of it's structure, the Last Forum Post mod needs to be hacked in order to provide the names that you want on screen.

Hacking the code should not be that hard. Use the `phorum_user_get()` function to retrieve the full user data and after that print out the real name in the user data instead of the author field from the posting. This probably isn't enough for you to fly on, but at least you'll have the steps to perform in the last post module to get the results you want. I'll see how far you got after I get back from my vacation ;-) Good luck!

If you look at the `real_name.php` script from the `real_name` version 2 mod, then you can find some example code. Here's a snippet (from line 174). The `$user_id` variable should contain the id of the user that posted the message.

- Added quoting options, which mimic the BBcode and Phorum default quoting methods, only with the real name used instead of the username. See the README for more information on using the quote functionality of the Real Names module.
- Added a check to see if the real_name custom field does HTML escaping on its own or not (based on the "HTML Disabled" field setting). If it doesn't, the real_name module will do the escaping to prevent XSS problems. This prevents the real_name from being escaped twice before displaying. A user with a real-name like "<john>" would be displayed as "<john>" on screen before.

Beware: this change has implications for the required behaviour for real_name plugins. The displayname that has to be returned by a plugin now has to be correctly HTML escaped. See also the README for this module.
