Ich habe ein paar Wochen lang das Forum (5.2.6) mit englischer Sprache benutzt. Jetzt tritt nach der Installation des Sprach-Packs ein ähnliches Problem auf: Die durch den Sprach-Pack übersetzten Sachen wie "Beiträge" werden korrekt dargestellt, allerdings werden Umlaute im Nachrichtentext und in der Überschrift nun verfremdet. Aus "Grüße" ist nun "GrÄœÄÿe" geworden, wenn ich die Nachricht ändere erscheint "Gr??e". Das Umstellen des Zeichensatzes hat nichts gebracht.

Irgendwelche Ideen?

For some weeks I used the phorum (5.2.6) with english language activated. After installing this german language-pack a similar problem occurs: the forum itself is on german without problems, but the messages I've wirtten before the switch to germen now are displayed incorrectly. The word "Grüße" is now "GrÃœÃÿe" and when I edit the message "Gr??e" appears after saving it. Changing the charset didn't help.

I tried to download the german.zip. The link is in the very first post. I normally click on the link and my browser asks me what i want to do But i get the "Permission denied error". Never had that error before.

I use FF 2.0.0.6 on a Unix OS.

With Opera the dialog works as expected, but not with Firefox.

The other thing was about the licence for phorum. From the wiki i see it is open source. Thats all! No more infos

about that. On the other hand i can't find a clearly visible copyright notice at phorum.org. If phorum runs under a standard GPL or Open Source licence, the code must be available for everybody and NOT only for registered users. It is right that everybody is able to download the source for phorum, but it is not correct to expect registration to download localization files. Someone should fix that. Make a pool for all downloads and you are done.

We investigated the server logs and it appears that your FireFox browser is sending broken / modified (strike whatever description you find appropriate, maybe you are doing this on purpose through some plugin or so) http refererr headers. It only sends www.phorum.org and not www.phorum.org/phorum5/...., causing the code to reject the download request since it doesn't appear to be initiated from the forums. Your Opera sends correct headers and is therefore able to download the file.

We changed the setting for the anti-leeching protection to allow downloads from the entire site. That should make the downloads work for your FireFox browser too.

Please fix your browser to either send correct refererrer or no referrers at all. Not something in the middle like now. That could get you in troubles with other sites that perform referrer checks as well.
