FYI: I updated your phorum\_api\_forums\_delete() function. I pushed it into a direction that is more compatible with the rest of the API code. A lot of old code was copied into the forums API, but functionality was already covered by existing functionality in the API.

From a functional perspective, the changes are:

- a changed return value (full \$forum data array instead of only the folder\_flag value from that array)
- a new module hook "admin\_folder\_delete"

I have to update the code that is effected by the API change (i.e. the admin interface). That will follow in my next
